

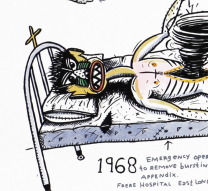
**CURRICULUM VITÆ** by **NORMAN C. COTHERINE. 1944-**

 1st tooth



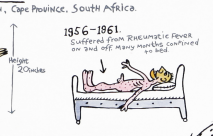
1968 Emergency operation

 being woken on the EPC



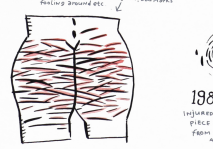
1956-1961 Suffered from Rheumatic Fever

 of a bicycle gas tank



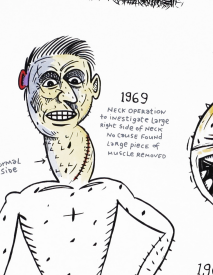
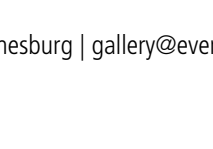
1969 Neck operation

 BOMB ON THE ASSOCIATED



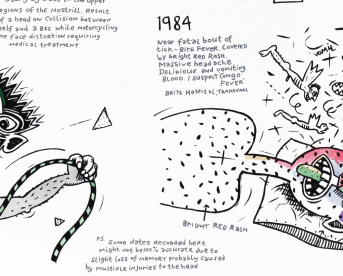
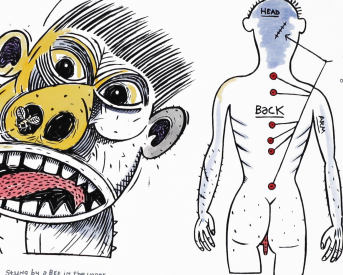
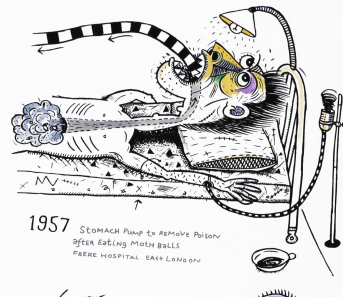
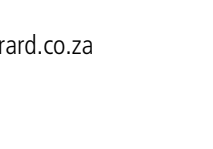
1967 Stung by a Bee in the upper

 by multiple injuries to the head



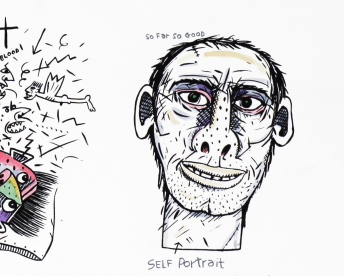
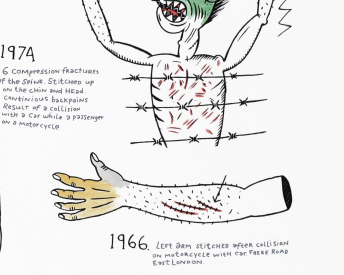
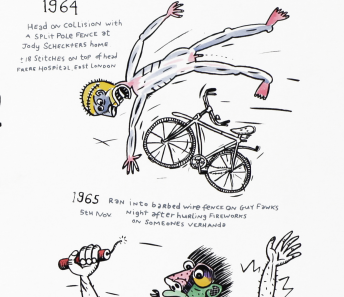
1964 Head on collision with
